

PACKING CHECK LIST FOR PATAGONIA HUT TO HUT

Attached is a list of items we hope helps you with your packing. Please let us know if you have any questions. Remember to pack lightly...see you soon!

There are no showers in the huts!

Backpack 65lts
Sleeping bag 10 °F – (-8 °C aprox) (800grs of down)
Headlamp (Petzl Tikka plus, Black diamond or similar)
Pocket knife or Leatherman
Piece of wire, few ski binding screws (if you have)
Waterbottle Nalgene or Camelbak
Crocs or light weight sandals (optional)
2 pairs of sintethic socks (like Columbia or similar)
Quick dry pants-(North face, Mammut or similar)
2 Polipropilene shirt and underwear
T shirt
Thin fleece
Thick fleece
down jacket (synthetic-Patagonia Puff- or down)
Water proof Goretex jacket
Water proof Goretex pants
Water proof Goretex gloves with insulation or similar
2 pairs of Fleece gloves or similar
Warm hat
Sun hat
Sunglasses with UV filter + Goggles
Sun screen and lipstick
Ipod or MP3 player- optional
Earplugs (for Mt huts, windy days in tents)
Tooth brush and paste

Ski gear

Telemark, Snowboard or ski touring bindings with skis
Skins
Telemark or ski touring boots
Probe, shovel and beacon
Boot crampons
Ski crampons
Ski poles
Ski Helmet
Harness, 2 locking binners

Paper work

Passport/visa (w/photo copy carried separately. Also leave a copy with someone at home)

Credit card/VISA/MASTER CARD. BANK automatic cash machines work the best

Credit card cancellation phone number

Starting cash in U.S. dollars

Bring cash in pesos (or change in US\$) up to the huts for beers/wine
